INTRODUCTION

Abhivyakti foundation registered under society registration act working for the up-liftmen of underprivileged women, children, adolescent, and other member of the society in the rural and urban area of several states of country on the issue of education, health, agriculture, livelihood, environment, entrepreneurship development, skill development to enhance the capacity and empowerment of community people. The organisational endeavour reflects in its commitment to thrive in executing the task at various level of community sustainability. Abhivyakti Foundation has been extensively and intensively working to enhance the socio-economic status of the downtrodden in urban and rural part of different states to make them self sustainable in terms of their growth and development through different community level programme to achieve its objective.

Established in the year 2001 Abhivyakti Foundation within its short period of its existence had laid a strong foundation in the areas of health sector especially Targeted Intervention on HIV/AIDs. This year, the main approach and strategy adopted was focused on providing and promoting maximum output efficiently and excelling to prevent the disease by various activities in order to reach the community. Concentration of work has been focused on the previous year's programmes and activities for more innovatively with thorough efforts.

Other activities include **community mobilization Programme** that includes formation and strengthening of Self Help Group (SHG), Micro Entrepreneurial Development Programme and Village Development Programme supported by **NABARD**. Besides, Activities such as running crèches, awareness generation campaigns and workshops by the support of Government and international agencies are going efficiently. The organization has close associated with NABARD and currently implementing SHG project in Palwal District. We have also successfully completed on SHPI project and VDP at Mirpur Korali. Abhivyakti Foundation having "Jute Bag manufacturing unit in Palwal" in association with NABARD. The organisation is also associated with NABARD in Jalandhar and Moga dist in Punjab for SHG programme and Tailoring and Embroidery. In which several products like Files, folders, School Bags, Shopping Bags, Pencil Box, Water Bottle, Lunch Box etc are manufactured and marketed by the SHG groups. The programme of tailoring and

embroidery (jacket production centre) in dist. Moga of Punjab another unit setup to meet the demand of the community women associated for SHG.

Major Area of Project Operation

During the year, programmes and activities of the organization were executed in Delhi, Punjab, U.P and Haryana and Jharkhand. In Delhi, the activities were implemented in slums, unauthorized and authorized colonies located in North West and central part of Delhi. In Haryana, the activities are executed in both urban and rural areas of Palwal districts. In U.P, Ghaziabad district is covered. In Punjab, Jalandhar and Moga districts covered.

Programme and Activities

Abhivyakti Foundation work through 2016-17 has been multi-dimensional. New projects were sanctioned under different organization. With previous projects and new projects in line, Abhivyakti Foundation is engaged in thorough planning to efficiently manage and implement the programs. The priority list of focused programmes was on Health, Education, and Research oriented projects. Our TI projects under different State Aids Control Society are one of the recognizable programme of the organization.

Health

Target Intervention (HIV/AIDS) Programme

One of the major thrust of the organization is to implement the Targeted Intervention Projects supported by various State AIDS Control Society under NACO. We have 05 TI Projects in total functioning in the State of Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Punjab and Delhi. As a part of the Programme, we conducted activities like Behaviour Change Communication (BCC), providing clinical services, networking and advocacy etc. The Programme is focused on MSM community in Delhi, IDU in Amritsar and Jalandhar (Punjab) FSW in Palwal and Transgender in Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh continued in the reporting year under TI program me.

Target Intervention Project at Ghaziabad Uttar Pradesh (Transgender)

Abhivyakti Foundation was identified for the functioning of TI Project among the Transgender in Ghaziabad for HIV/AIDS prevention by the UPSACS. It was established in the month of August 2013 with 250 target beneficiaries. In course of four year of project implementation and in the target year of 2017 Abhivyakti tried to meet the project objective for the promotion of condoms, linkages with to STI (sexually transmitted infection) management services, community outreach, referral and networking , strong networks and follow up. Organizing health camp is another programme to inculcate sensitivity and generate awareness regarding the various health issues and to facilitate self-learning to enable the client to become independent. Linkages to others services for voluntary counselling and testing centre VCTC was also a prerequisite. Counselling for social and emotional support to target group through one to one/ one to group interaction were conducted. Targeted beneficiaries visit the Drop in Centre at their wishful hour where they relax and involve in recreational activities as the group feels free and comfortable while at DIC. The achievement target was 289 beneficiaries against 250 beneficiaries identified for the control and prevention of HIV/AIDS amongst target population and to increase awareness on STD/HIV/AIDS among the clinic attendees and targeted Population.



Target Intervention Project at Jalandhar Dist Punjab

(Injected Drug Uses)

Under the ambit of PSACS, (Punjab State AIDS Control Society) under NACO Abhivyakti Foundation was identified for the functioning of TI Project among the IDUs in Jalandhar for HIV/AIDS prevention. It was established in the month of June 2009 with 600 target beneficiaries. In the financial year 2017 the main objective achieve was to promote condoms, linkages to STI (Sexually Transmitted Infection) services and a strong networks and follow up system. Linkages to others services for voluntary counselling and testing centre VCTC was also a prerequisite. Counselling for social and emotional support to target group through one to one/ one to group interaction is conducted. The project achieved the given target of 600 beneficiaries to provide services and counselling to control and prevention of HIV/AIDS amongst target population.

Major achievements were- CSC won the best performer award in Punjab from PSACS. CSC arranged the 15 marriages of PLHIV clients till date. Referred 1794 PLHIVs for social welfare schemes, out of this 1092 cases has been linked under different schemes and entitlements. CSC has solced 22 DRT cases till now and screened 2051 PLHIVs for T.B in HIV till 2017.



Target Intervention Project at Amritsar District of Punjab (Injected Drug Users)

The TI project Under the banner of PSACS, (Punjab State AIDS Control Society) and NACO, Abhivyakti Foundation was identified for the implementation of TI Project among the IDUs in Amritsar for HIV/AIDS prevention. It was established in the month of Dec 2013 with 400 target beneficiaries. In the year 2017 the main project objective was to improve the survival and quality of life of people living with HIV/AIDS (PLHIV) by establishing care and support centre (CSCs) in Amritsar, Bhatinda, Jalandhar, Ludhiyana, Patiala, Pathankot and Firozpur. The project achieved the target of 405 beneficiaries for this to provide need based treatment and care and support to prevent HIV/AIDS and reduce stigma and discrimination amongst target population.

The major achievements are- on the basis of our performance proposal sent for becoming learning site at state level. Proposal sent for OST for Abhivyakti foundation. Spouse training conducted for making candle and soya bean milk at hotspot in Indira colony in April 2016. The other initiatives taken were – Spouse Intervention, children camp for health and hygiene and art and craft, hepatitis Intervention with MAMTA.



Target Intervention Project at Burari, Delhi (Male Sex with Male)

Abhivyakti is taking TI MSMs project supported by DSACS to prevent HIV/AIDS among the identified target group from 2008 in Burari of Delhi. The main objective of the project is to create awareness on condom promotion, linkages to STI (sexually transmitted infection) services and has services with a strong networks and follow up system. Organizing health camp is another programme to inculcate sensitivity and generate awareness regarding the various health issues and to facilitate self-learning to enable self to become independent. Linkages to others services for voluntary counselling and testing centre VCTC is also a prerequisite. Counselling for social and emotional support to target group through one to one/ one to group interaction is conducted. The achievement target is 1250 beneficiaries for this project to provide information of control and prevention of HIV/AIDS amongst target population to increase awareness about STD/HIV/AIDS among the clinic attendees and targeted Population.



Learning Site 'Hifazat Project'

Through the (EHA) Emmanuel Health Association, Abhivyakti Foundation caters to implement the IDU harm-reduction training component of 'Project Hifazat'. Abhivyakti Foundation is thus a sub-recipient of **Emmanuel Health Association** and covers capacity building of IDU, TI, and NGOs in Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand in the harm reduction component. For improved performance and quality training to different categories of staff working with NGO-s/CBO-s viz., Counsellors, Outreach Workers, Peer Educators and Link

Workers is necessary. For such EHA that supports these activities identified learning sites that program staff from other TI NGOs to carry out operations research on identifying barriers to access and uptake of HIV counselling and test and treatment for sexually transmitted infections.

Mahila Panchayat

Abhivyakti in support and partnership with **Delhi Commission for Women**, has undertaken Mahila Panchayat Programme commenced from **16th of March 2012** at Burari and Bhalaswa of North Delhi. The main objective of the programme was to creating mass awareness on legal rights of women and addresses their issues to solve their legal problem. **Mahila Panchayat** is an initiative taken for empowerment of women mainly of underprivileged section of the society. The project offer crisis intervention and legal aid at community level and help tackle local level legal disputes and assist in reduction and reconciliation of violence against women. Mahila Panchayat take up the cases and resolve them at the community level. These cases mainly pertain to bigamy, maintenance, domestic violence, alcoholism and other issues. In the most cases Panchayat have been able to resolve the cases at their mutual level.

STep Programme, Burari (Smile Foundation)

Abhivyakti in partnership with smile foundation implementing a Skill development cum job placement programme to engage the youth in labour market. The main objective of the programme is to impart skill and opportunity to underprivileged youth of the community for Job and support in Job placement according to their capacity. The step programme helps the student to gain basic knowledge and technical skill in Computer education, personality development, English speaking and marketing through practical session to enhance their employability skill and placement opportunity to get the desired job in the market. The centre provides spoken English classes and personality development programme to strengthen the capacity of the youth in job placement. Rajive Gandhi Crèches Programme

There are huge numbers of children left uncared and unattended during the day as many women folk are busy with the work concerned. In order to give proper shelter and nutrition to the infants while their mothers are busy at work, such children are identified and brought to the Crèche. Initiated in the year 2010, Abhivyakti Foundation identified **50** children under the age group of **0-6** years to deliver early childhood Education, Nutrition, care & support to these children. These crèches are running in one semi-rural and one rural area (**Begampur and Ladpur, Delhi**) The program me is supported by **Delhi Social Welfare Board**.



Education

The formal education programme which came in 2010. It covered through two different courses namely **Bachelor Preparatory Programme (BPP) & CLP** under **IGNOU** and Condensed Course of Central Social Welfare Board.

Micro Insurance Scheme

Established in the year 2007, Abhivyakti Foundation has identified the income group families living in unauthorized and authorized colonies of Delhi to be supported through micro insurance scheme of **Life Insurance Corporation**. During the year, 1200 are policy holders in the scheme. Majority of insured persons belong to low income group as they are able to manage the premium of minimum Rs. 100 and maximum 500 per month. Time period is five years to 15 years. The scheme provides auto cover of accidental insurance and other benefits to the beneficiaries under the scheme.

Formation of SHG and Bank Linkages Scheme under National Bank of Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD)

PALWAL - HARYANA

Under the aegis of NABARD, a Project on SHG formation and linkages with Bank remains a consistent project of Abhivyakti Foundation. In the current year, a number of 35 SHG is formed from Palwal district i.e. Palwal, Hasanpur, Hodal and Hathin etc there are total 150. In dist. of Punjab in Nakoder 62 SHGs has been formed and functional, after the completion of 02 years, and 68 SHG is formed further and provided skill development programme such as VDP, SDI are introduced and promotion of Skill development is enhanced. Under this programme, the SHG members are trained in manufacture of jute bag. Under this programme around 30 women are benefited. The project also establishes to link the beneficiary with Bank so that they can avail the bank facilities at their own expense.

This year too, a team of Abhivyakti Foundation participated in the Saras Mela at Mumbai in the month of January and also participated in the Suraj Kund Mela the month of February at Faridabad, CII Mela in Chandigarh. The articles made of jute in various types like file **folder, carry-bags, School Bags, Shopping Bags, Pencil Box, Water Bottle, Lunch Box etc.** Abhivyakti Foundation having “**Jute Bag manufacturing unit in Palwal**” in association with NABARD, Abhivyakti Foundation is also associated with NABARD in **Jalandhar and Moga** dist in Punjab for SHG programme and Tailoring and Embroidery. The programme of tailoring and embroidery (**jacket production centre**) in dist. Moga of Punjab.

Community Support Centre

Established in the year 2012 at Jalandhar CSC extends care and support to the 1000 beneficiaries of HIV Positive.

At CSC, we follow palliative care approach which improves the quality of life of patients and their families facing the problem associated with the illness through the prevention and relief of suffering by means of early identification and impeccable assessment and treatment of pain and other problems, physical, psychological and emotional. Conducting regular contact with community members and promoting counselling sessions is also conducted by Abhivyakti Foundation. Providing social services for the purpose of livelihood support for their betterment, aware them for free treatment in government hospitals, to provide welfare services given by government such as Ration card, bank account, donations, scholarships, pensions etc.






